Quilt #3 - Christmas Diamonds **56 x 64 inches**

3,584 square inches, 24.9 square feet,
2.77 square yards

Quilt details -

Outer printed border is 6 inches, inner
border is 2 inches, blocks are 8 inches

#1 Are you computerized or hand guided?

Hand guided - 7
Computerized - 2

#2 What would you charge to quilt this quilt?

#3 How did you calculate the price

2 people charged \$72 - .02 cents per square inch
1 person charged \$80 - .017 cents per square inch + \$20 for custom border work
1 person charged \$96.60 - .025 cents per square inch
1 person charged \$110 - .03 cents per square inch
2 people charged - \$179.20 - .05 cents per square inch. One person commented this price was for ruler work.
1 person wrote - \$150 This fits into my medium category, and includes batting and thread.
1 person wrote - \$200 This price is based on the amount of time and the designs used. Borders would be a different design than the blocks and the blocks would be individually stitched.
1 person wrote - \$125 This is a per hour price. Note - the number of hours and the price per hour were not specified

#4 What pattern(s) / design(s) would you use? If using free hand designs, be somewhat specific as to pattern / design and where it is placed on the quilt

Response - I would quilt Christmas figs/berries in the outer border. Stitch in the ditch on the inner border and then edge to edge Christmas bells along each row of blocks (6 rows). I would bury the thread ends on each row of the inner blocks.

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Response - I'd really enjoy using rulers on this quilt. I'd do echoing chevrons in the diamond blocks and outer corners of the square in a square, and some type of continuous design in the middles of those blocks. Or I might decide to emphasize the larger diamonds and use rulers to make those stand out in a few places and do something different in the rest.

Response - Snowflakes e-2e

Response - The 6 inch border would probably be a flower and leaf design that complimented the fabrics in the body of the quilt. The 2" border would be a simple parallel wave. Each of the blocks would be quilted with a poinsettia design that filled the block.

Response - outer border- paisley feather with pine leaves and ribbon curls green
narrow border- holly leaves blocks-all over with paisley swirls, holly leaves, ribbon curls, pine needles, berries (circles)

Response - Outline center blocks house and stars. Fill in background. Ruler each border

Response – pantograph

Response - I would use an all-over design, perhaps Christmas motifs

Response - Holly leaves and ribbon pantograph

Response - free hand loops and Christmas trees on the large border. Christmas lights freehand on the small border. Loopy all over with Christmas motifs mixed in the center section.

#6 What thread would you use? What color(s) and where would they be placed?

- A light pretty green in all areas would be my choice, but the customer would pick their color.
- I'd probably stick to one color, a grey or lighter green that would blend nicely all across the quilt.
- Superior Variegated red/white all over.
- Colors would be red, white and maybe green. Borders might get white and blocks would probably be red. The thread would probably be polyester.
- medium gray
- 3 people responded – White thread
- 2 people responded – red or green thread

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#7 Do you have a separate thread charge? If so, how much would you charge for thread on this quilt?

- 6 people said they have no thread charge
- 2 people charged \$7
- 1 person charged \$6
- 1 person said - Yes. I charge per bobbin based on the cost of the thread.
Note: They did not specify how much the bobbin charge was or how many bobbins (estimated) would be used.
